PROFILE

ALI MCGREGOR is a singer, producer and arts maker based in Melbourne. She started her career as a principal soprano with Opera Australia then ran away with the circus in the form of hit show *La Clique (La Soirée)*. Ali is now an award winning cabaret and operatic performer and arts maker who has performed worldwide from Glastonbury to Carnegie Hall and is one of the most in demand performers on the international festival circuit. She was nominated for an ARIA award in 2014 and in 2015 was awarded a Green Room Award for her contribution to cabaret.

After wrapping two critically acclaimed seasons as Co - Artistic Director for Adelaide Cabaret Festival 2016/2017 alongside Eddie Perfect, Ali then returned as sole Artistic Director in 2018. Her most recent projects include a mesmerising show about famed Peruvian soprano Yma Sumac for which she won a coveted Helpmann award in 2019 and a critically acclaimed operatic cabaret conceived for Victorian Opera - Lorelei with music/Lyrics by Casey Bennetto, Gillian Cosgriff & Julian Langdon that debuted at The Malthouse Theatre in November 2018.
